Channel work will be avoided during the fish-spawning season (April 1 through June 30).	
Materials identified as containing potential hazardous materials will be characterized and removed for appropriate disposal.	
A phase 2 study will be performed in project areas where earthmoving activities will disturb soils at a depth of 24 inches or greater.

All construction activities will be limited to normal working hours so as to not disturb adjacent properties unless otherwise authorized by regulating agencies.	
All construction equipment will be maintained to provide proper noise abatement for adjacent properties.	
Provision shall be made for prompt removal from traveled roadways of all dirt and other materials that have been deposited thereon by operations concerned with the project whenever the accumulation is sufficient to cause the formation of dust and mud, interfere with drainage, damage pavements, or create a traffic hazard. Construction methods and means shall be employed to keep flying dust and air pollution to a minimum. Provision shall be made for the control of dust on the project and on roads, streets, and other areas affected by the project wherever such dust affects traffic or buildings, or construction materials. The materials and methods used for dust control shall be subject to approval.
