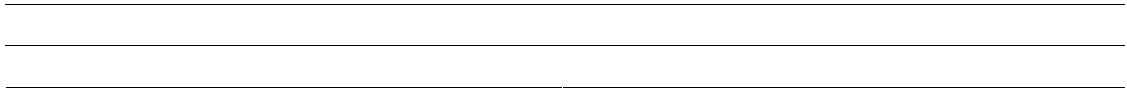

Resolution 2006-08

A resolution amending the Monroe County Comprehensive Land Use Plan to include the Monroe County Alternative Transportation and Greenways System Plan.

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Plan Commission prepared a proposed form of Monroe County Comprehensive Land Use Plan between mid-1986 and early 1995;

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Plan Commission approved and certified the proposed Monroe County Comprehensive Land Use Plan to the Board of Commissioners ("Board") of the County of Monroe, Indiana, on January 18, 1996;

WHEREAS, the Board adopted the certified form of the Monroe County Comprehensive Land Use Plan on February 2, 1996, as the official Monroe County Comprehensive Land Use Plan;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code Section 36-7-4-511 states that comprehensive land use plans may be amended through the same procedures specified for the adoption of comprehensive plans;

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Plan Commission conducted an advertised public hearing on the proposed Comprehensive Land Use Plan amendment, on the following date, and heard and accepted all public comments and objections during the hearing: March 21, 2006.

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Plan Commission found that the proposed Comprehensive Land Use Plan amendments fairly addressed the comments and objections presented during the foregoing public hearings;

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Plan Commission further found that the adoption of the proposed Comprehensive Land Use Plan amendment ("Plan Amendment") would promote the health, safety, morals, convenience, order, and general welfare of the citizens of Monroe County, Indiana, and would promote efficiency and economy in the process of land development throughout the unincorporated areas of Monroe County, Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Monroe County Plan Commission approved the Plan Amendment on March 21, 2006, and certified the Plan Amendment to the Board of Commissioners of the County of Monroe, Indiana ("Board of Commissioners");

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has received and reviewed the Plan Amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby finds that the adoption of the Plan Amendment would promote the health, safety, morals, convenience, order, and general welfare of the citizens of Monroe County, Indiana, and would promote efficiency and economy in the process of land development throughout the unincorporated areas of Monroe County, Indiana;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners as follows:


- Section 1. A copy of the Plan Amendment, as certified, is attached to this resolution and is incorporated herein. The certified Plan Amendment shall be, and hereby is, approved by the Board of Commissioners as an amendment to the Comprehensive Land Use Plan of Monroe County, Indiana.
- Section 2. The Monroe County Plan Commission Secretary shall be, and hereby is, directed to amend the Comprehensive Land Use Plan of Monroe County, Indiana, to reflect the amendment.
- Section 3. The Monroe County Auditor shall be, and hereby is, directed to place one (1) copy of the certified Plan Amendment on file in the office of the Monroe County Recorder, pursuant to I.C. 36-7-4-509(b).
- Section 4. The provisions of the resolution are separable. If any part or provision of this resolution or the application thereof to any persons or circumstances is adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part, provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this resolution or the applications thereof to other persons or circumstances. The Board of Commissioners hereby declares that it would have enacted the remainder of these regulations even without any such part, provision, or application.




